“Nicole Breeze is the Director of Australian Programs, and leads UNICEF Australia's policy and advocacy portfolio to influence policy makers, legislators and the private sector so that the rights of children, especially those experiencing greatest disadvantage, are protected and promoted. She has significant experience in leadership and management roles in not for profit organisations in Australia and internationally, including in senior roles with Oxfam Australia leading their International Youth Partnerships initiative across 92 countries, and as Executive Manager leading major external and internal projects.”
